







MONASTERY OF THE DISCALCED CARMELITES OF SAN JOSÉ

Second Foundation of Saint Theresa

Founded by Saint Theresa in August 15th, 1567 it is considered the second house of the reformed Carmelo. The original rooms of the foundation, which are kept intact since then, can be visited in small groups following this itinerary: The museum of Saint Theresa, in which artistic works, personal belongings and Saint Theresa's relics are displayed; The original room where the first meeting with Saint John of the Cross took place; The old courtyard with the "Passage of the Saint", a perfect example of traditional architecture from the 16th century in Medina del Campo; Two cells of the old convent in which the austerity of the Carmelite Reform is stated; The original cell of Saint Theresa reconverted to oratory chapel in 1682 and the convent church, built between 1596 and 1603 according to the traditional canon followed by convent temples of the age.

Types of visits:

Guided tours

The duration of the guided tour is approximately 45 minutes. All the tours will be guided and in groups (maximum 20 people) Prior reservation will be required.

There is a donation of 2 € per person.

For tours in other languages, possibility of simultaneous translation if the group has its own translator.

Due to the Fifth Centenary of Saint Theresa of the Cross, between October 15th and December 14th 2014, the Museum will host the exhibition "Saint Theresa of Jesus and Saint John of the Cross: The Meeting" dedicated to the meeting which took place in Medina del Campo in October 1567. This meeting will be essential for the future of the order. Sculptures of magnificent sculptors such as Juan de Juni, Juan Picardo, Gregorio Fernández, Juan Montejo, Esteban de Rueda..., paintings of masters such as Luca Giordano, Marcellus Coffermans, Juan Pantoja de la Cruz, Diego Valentín Díaz..., engravings of Adriaen Collaert and Cornelius Galle..., first editions of the works of Saint Theresa, Saint John, Fray Luis de León...will be displayed in this exhibition.
